
Guideline of the 2017 Nagoya University International Summer Seminar

Nagoya University, School of Law

1. Outline of the Program :

CAMPUS Asia Program of Nagoya University Graduate School of Law and School of Law, will host the 6th "International Summer Seminar (ISS)", in cooperation with partner universities. The ISS provides students with opportunities to discover and experience student life in Japan and to interact with students from China, Japan and Korea.

Cultivating their practical skills and knowledge, we hope that participants will be a major force in the future development of Asian countries. This seminar will be a first step in the development of student's international consciousness and will allow them to begin developing international networks with participants from China, Japan and Korea. Participation in this program will be a great opportunity to discover Japan, gain new knowledge, and meet life-long friends.

2. Qualification for Participants :

Must belong to affiliated schools, and have been recommended by the home university.

*Note: Participating universities should take the following into account when making recommendations

- i) Applicant should be enthusiastic, have initiative, and be able to work independently or in cooperation with others.
- ii) Applicant must be in good physical and mental condition.
- iii) Applicant must be able to understand lectures in English.

*Around TOEIC750 or iBT-TOEFL80 at the time of arrival

- iiii) *Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.30 from the last year on the evaluation scale described below.

[GPA Formula]:

$$\frac{([No. \text{ of GP3 credits}] \times 3) + ([No. \text{ of GP2 Credits}] \times 2) + ([No. \text{ of GP1 Credits}] \times 1) + ([No. \text{ of GP0 Credits}] \times 0)}{\text{Total number of registered credits}}$$

*No. = Number / *GP = Grade Point

Note:

- a) If applicants have taken courses that are not part of the credit system, replace the number of credits in the GPA formula with the number of courses taken.
- b) Grades of "Pass" or/and "Accreditation" which have no grade points are not included into GPA calculation.
- c) When calculating GPA, truncate a number to two decimal places. Ex., 2.654 will be 2.65.

5. Credit Transfer / Certificate of the International Summer Seminar :

Credits issued by this program can be transferred into the credits of their original universities under certain conditions. Students who are interested should inquire about the conditions and the method of transfer to their universities.

August July 31st, 2017 (Mon) to August 9th, 2017 (Wed)

- Application Form
- Three Identical photograph (attach to the application form) (3.5cm x 4.5cm)
- Copy of Language Proficiency certificate
*i.e., TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS
- Official Certificate of Enrolment in English
(to be issued by the institution presently being attended)
- Copy of the information page of the student's passport
*If you have not obtained your passport by the indicated deadline, please make sure to submit a copy as soon as you receive it.
- Curriculum Vitae (Only Graduate applicants who wish to participate in the Internship)

10. Fee :

Participants are responsible for travel expenses to/from Nagoya and expenses such as food and daily necessities. (Accommodation is provided without charge to all participants)
